## 2022 Greenville Day Frequently Asked Questions

### **Where is Greenville Day located?**

Greenville Day is located in the George V. Vanderbilt Park in the Town of Greenville in Greene County (located near the border of Albany County). The street address of Vanderbilt Park is [11380 NY-32, Greenville NY 12083](#). It is located a half mile north of the traffic light found at the intersection of Routes 81 and 32. Look for Greenville Day signs at the entrance to the park on Town Park Road. Note: Most of the park is hidden on the west side off Route 32.

Please note:

Greenville Day and The Town of Greenville are NOT located in Orange County.

### **I'm coming to enjoy the event, where do I park?**

Parking is provided in several paved and grass areas in the park. Most parking is on uneven grass. Follow signs and event staff in marked green shirts. There is no fee for parking and event access, but a suggested donation is encouraged (\$5 per vehicle) to support Greenville Day. As a not-for-profit event, Greenville Day depends on your donations to keep going.

### **Why are parts of this event FREE?**

Greenville Day is organized and staffed by the non-profit Community Partners of Greenville, the Town of Greenville, and local volunteers. It is supported by generous donations by local businesses, the Town of Greenville and a Greene County Speenburgh grant.

### **Where is accessible parking for this event?**

There is a limited number of accessibility parking spaces available next to the main tent. A valid accessible placard is required for these spaces and we ask that they be used only by individuals with severe mobility issues. For all others, a golf cart

shuttle will run constantly from other parking areas. If you require accessible parking assistance or shuttle, please find an event staff or volunteer in a marked green shirt and notify them of your assistance needs. We will accommodate as best as we can depending on space availability at the time.

**I have a large vehicle, where do I park?**

Large vehicles such as trucks, trailers and RVs must park at the back of the park (away from the main road). Drive straight along Town Park road to the back and ask event staff for directions on where to park. Do not park along Town Park road or you will be towed. It is a fire lane.

**I'm a registered vendor, where do I park?**

**Where do I drop off or pick up my passengers if I don't want to park?**

A drop off area is marked on the right side of the Town Park road near the main tent. Drivers must remain in their vehicle and the maximum drop off/pick up wait time is 3 minutes.

---

**What at Greenville Day is free?**

All parking, Friday night hot dogs, craft fair/expo access, fireworks, hay rides, live music and certain demonstrations, pony rides and the kids amusement park rides are FREE.

Food trucks and craft vendors sell food and gifts for a fee.

---

**If I need cash, is there an ATM?**

There are no ATMs in Vanderbilt Park. Some craft vendors may take credit cards. The nearest ATM is located at the Bank of Greene County or National Bank of Coxsackie which are a quarter mile from the park on route 32 in either direction.

---

**Where are the bathrooms?**

Bathrooms are located as port-a-potties next to the first aid station and there are some restrooms inside the North Barn located next to the main tent. Hand washing stations are also provided.

---

**Where is the command center for this event?**

The marked command center is located next to the main tent. Additionally, event staff and volunteers will be walking around in marked green T-shirts.

---

**Is there mass transit to Greenville Day?**

Unfortunately, there are no busses or mass transit options to get to Vanderbilt Park.

---

**Can I bring alcohol, tobacco to Greenville Day?**

Per the Town of Greenville local ordinances posted at the George V. Vanderbilt Town Park, all weapons, alcohol, tobacco, vaping and recreational drugs of any kind are all not permitted in the park. They are also not allowed at Greenville Day. If event staff suspect that any local, state or federal laws are being violated, a Greene County Sheriff will be called to investigate.

---

**What if it rains or there are storms?**

In the event of rain, Greenville Day will still be held, but certain portions of the event may be modified, cancelled, or relocated in consideration of grass turf impact and safe operations. In the event of stormy weather, Greenville Day may be subject to temporary closure and/or cancellation. In these circumstances, audio announcements will be made. There is no alternate rain date for Greenville Day.

**I'm an event volunteer for Greenville Day. Where do I go?**

Visit the command center first to check in and receive instructions on your volunteer assignment. Be sure to also visit the command center at the end of your volunteer period to check out. If you have a vehicle, please park your vehicle in the general parking area towards the back of the park or where directed by event staff.
